I also understand that the district attorney's office may elect to take a voluntary dismissal with leave of the above charges and present any felony charges to a lawfully empaneled Grand Jury at any time in the future and if such Grand Jury finds that probable cause exist a True Bill of Indictment may be issued resulting in me being arrest again for the same offense(s).

I am not under any pressure or duress and freely and knowingly hereby waive my right to a Probable Cause Hearing understanding the above-referenced charges will now be transferred to the jurisdiction of the Superior Court. I have had the opportunity to consult with and discuss with my attorney, Harold Cogdell, Jr., about my decision to waive probable cause in the above-captioned matter.
